Hurricane Harvey Disaster Relief, Race Ethnicity Disability Form, Records Retention and Training

Virginia has posted [Disaster Relief Guidelines](#) on our website. If you wish to provide temporary emergency housing assistance to households displaced because of a presidentially declared Major Disaster, contact VHDA.

Tax credit property managers should begin using the updated [Race Ethnicity Disability Form](#) immediately. Have applicants provide data and sign this form at the time of move-in.

Tax exempt bond funded property managers may want to review updated Guidelines which addresses records retention and clarifies what type of actions to use in WTCMS for recertifications.
