VHDA Awards VA Tech Memorial Scholarship

RICHMOND – The Virginia Housing Development Authority recently awarded its 2013 Hokie Memorial Residential Property Management (RPM) Scholarship to Dan Nguyen of Fairfax. The scholarship totals \$3,500.

Nguyen, a University Honors student, is a sophomore in the Virginia Tech RPM program and plans to double-major in Residential Property Management and Real Estate, with a minor in Business.

She also plans to complete an internship this summer with Kettler Management, which is based in McLean, VA. An internship is a built-in part of the RPM program, and many students complete more than one.

The VHDA Board of Commissioners established the VHDA Hokie Memorial Residential Property Management Scholarship fund at Virginia Tech in memory of the Virginia Tech faculty and students who were victims of the 2007 tragedy. The VHDA fund provides two scholarships each year – one in the fall semester and one in the spring semester – to qualified students in Virginia Tech’s Residential Property Management Program.

“We are very grateful for VHDA’s scholarship program for our residential property management students here at Virginia Tech,” said Dr. Rosemary Goss, RPM Advisory Board Professor. “As the cost of tuition continues to increase, scholarships are even more meaningful to our student population.”

VHDA’s strategic plan continues to place a strong focus on property management, which is critical to ensuring that communities view affordable housing as an asset.
